Bay Engaged launched in 2018 to nurture a vibrant network of Bay Area Latinx philanthropy professionals and to build a collective vision for leveraging philanthropy to address issues impacting the Latinx community. The Bay Engaged network is made up of Latinx participants across the Bay Area that share a desire to address the philanthropic sector's historic underinvestment of Latinx causes and communities.
